## Year 2000 Compliance for Netscape Application Server

Dear Valued Netscape Customer:

Netscape Communications Corporation ("Netscape") confirms that the Netscape Application Server ("Application Server") has been tested to certify it is "Year 2000 Compliant", as defined below, when configured and used in accordance with the related documentation; provided the underlying Operating System(s) ("OS(s)") of the host machine, and any non Netscape-owned software provided with or in the host machine or Application Server, are also Year 2000 Compliant.

**The Netscape Application Server will require a software patch to be Year 2000 Compliant. Please refer to the following URL location for the Application Server Year 2000 Patch Readme file which includes the link for the patch download site: <http://help.netscape.com/products/server/nas/y2k.html>**

The Application Server relies on the date-handling capabilities of the underlying OS. Processing and display of date information through the user interface is dependent on the date data provided by the underlying OS, and will be correct if that OS and other non Netscape-owned software are Year 2000 Compliant. Concerns regarding Year 2000 Compliance of the host OS should be directed to the provider of that OS.

Netscape has not tested this software on all platforms of all OSs that it currently supports. Therefore, it is imperative that the user of the software verify that the underlying OS and platform support the transition to the year 2000.

"Year 2000 Compliant" is defined as the ability to: (i) correctly handle date information needed for the December 31, 1999 to January 1, 2000 date change; (ii) function according to the related documentation accompanying the Application Server needed for the December 31, 1999 to January 1, 2000 date change, without changes in operation resulting from the advent of the new century assuming correct configuration; (iii) where appropriate, respond to two digit date input in a way that resolves the ambiguity as to century in a disclosed, defined and predetermined manner; (iv) if the date elements in interfaces and data storage specify the century, store and provide output of date information in ways that are unambiguous as to century; and (v) recognize year 2000 as a leap year.
